Mali Crisis

#### **Cluster Responsibilities:**

• WFP is leading ETC activities in Mali with responsibility for coordination, implementation and overall operation support for common ICT services.

#### **Activities and Achievements:**

• Nyanaprakash Muniandy, from WFP FITTEST, replaced Ozdzan Hadziemin, also from FITTEST, as ETC coordinator at the beginning of December.

#### **Challenges and Gaps:**

- The five radio operators recruited to work in the COMCEN in Mopti have not yet been deployed as they have yet to receive medical clearance.
- The tense security situation remains an on-going challenge for humanitarian operations across Mali. Security in Bamako is relatively calm, however the north of the country remains a no-travel area for UN personnel.
  - Security advice from UNDSS has been to remain vigilant and exercise caution.

#### **Planned Activities:**

- It is unlikely that there will be a military intervention in the North in the near future. However, as a preparedness measure, ETC plans for 2013 will take into account the situation in neighbouring countries as refugees may flee to them to escape any fighting.
  - If military intervention in the north results in deterioration of the security situation in Mopti then Segou or San will be used as backup locations.
  - Equipment has already been purchased for potential deployment to these locations. It has not been decided which of these two locations will be used, but it is likely to be Segou due to its large runway and proximity to Mopti. There are also hotels with sufficient security. Organizations are working on a common contingency plan.

 The ETC will resume reprogramming radios for humanitarian organizations due to interference on the existing NGO frequency. There will be around 1000 radios to reprogramme.

## **Meetings:**

The Global ETC teleconferences for Mali will now be held on an as-needed basis. Regular updates will continue to be shared on the ICT HEP website.
