Mali Crisis

Cluster Responsibilities:

- WFP is leading ETC activities in Mali with responsibility for coordination, implementation and overall operation support for common ICT services.
- The security situation in Bamako is calm, however the situation in the north remains tense, particularly in Gao and Kidal.
 - Presidential elections took place on 28/07/13 without incident.

Activities and Achievements:

- Data connectivity is now being provided to the humanitarian community in Timbuktu.
 - Security telecommunications services are also being provided.
- The ETC continues to support the humanitarian community through the installation and programming of radios:
 - To date, 577 handheld and 60 vehicle radios have been reprogrammed.
 - HF radios have been reprogrammed in Bamako due to conflicting call signs with a field office in Côte d'Ivoire.
 - A daily radio check is conducted at 20:30.
- An assessment mission was conducted in Gao and identified the UN common area as a suitable location for eventual ETC deployment.

Challenges and Gaps:

- The radio room in Timbuktu is not operational 24/7 due to staffing constraints.
 - UNDSS is currently in the process of recruiting radio operators for deployment to Timbuktu.
- Three additional radio operators recruited for deployment to Mopti are awaiting approval.
 - The radio room in Mopti is not operational 24/7 and closes at 20:00 or 21:00.

Planned Activities:

- There are plans to deploy to Gao, Kidal and Kayes in the coming weeks, however this is dependent on the security situation.
 - All of the equipment required for deployment to Gao has already been prepared.

- Due to the security situation in Kidal, international UN staff are not cleared for deployment.
