Mali Crisis

Cluster Responsibilities:

- WFP is leading ETC activities in Mali with responsibility for coordination, implementation and overall operation support for common ICT services.
- The security situation in Bamako is calm, however the situation in the north remains tense, particularly in Gao and Kidal.

Activities and Achievements:

- Ozdzan Hadziemin has replaced Nyanaprakash Muniandy as ETC Coordinator in Mali.
- A mission was deployed to Gao on 17/09/13 to install data connectivity. Once complete, wireless services will be shared with the humanitarian community.
- Data and security telecommunications services are being provided to the humanitarian community in Timbuktu.
- The ETC continues to support the humanitarian community through the installation and programming of radios:
 - o To date, 577 handheld and 60 vehicle radios have been reprogrammed.
 - A daily radio check is conducted at 20:00.
- Two BUCs have arrived in Bamako from emergency.lu. These will be tested before deployment.

Challenges and Gaps:

- Kidal is still a no-go area for humanitarian staff.
- There is a shortage of radio operators across the country. Five radio operators each are required for the radio rooms in Mopti, Timbuktu and Gao in order for them to be operational 24/7. Currently Bamako is the only city in which this is the case. The radio room in Mopti is only open during the day as there are only two radio operators there.
- There is a need for more TDY staff. More may be joining by the end of the month and extensions will be requested for others.
- Problems have been experienced in Mopti with a satellite terminal.
 - Rx SNR is currently around 2.3 Db.
 - A replacement Proxim link has been shipped from Gao to Mopti as a temporary solution, however a BSU and SU will be shipped from Dubai as a permanent solution.

- A faulty WIDER previously used in RoSS is currently under repair in Spain. This may be shipped to Mali once fixed.
 - Two kits have been requested by the ETC in Mali, though there is a preference for new kits rather than used ones.
- The Zone Director in Gao was faulty so it has been disconnected and shipped back to Dubai.
- The ISP in Mopti is functioning, however in Timbuktu and Gao it is unreliable.

Planned Activities:

- Discussions are being held between the ETC, WFP and MINUSMA regarding potential sharing of radio rooms, however nothing has yet been confirmed.
- There are plans to deploy to Kidal after Gao, however no dates have been finalised. Equipment will be prepared accordingly.
