



Emergency telecommunications services for the humanitarian community

ETC Situation Report #08

Syria Crisis

Reporting period 17/07/2013 to 22/08/2013

Summary:

- An IASC System-Wide Emergency was activated on 15/01/13. Humanitarian organizations are scaling up operations in response to the evolving crisis. Only the ETC and Logistics Cluster have been activated in Syria to date.
- The ETC is attempting to provide common telecommunications services within Syria, however lack of access and restrictions on movement have complicated these efforts and have led to a number of missions being cancelled.

Cluster Responsibilities:

- The ETC in Syria is providing emergency telecommunications support to humanitarian organizations on the ground including VHF/HF radio programming and installation.
- Responsibility for the provision of ETC/Common ICT services across the region is shared between WFP (Syria, Turkey and Iraq) and UNHCR (Lebanon and Jordan).
 - WFP is providing support to UNHCR telecommunications service provision if and when required.
 - WFP coordinates regional activities in close collaboration with UNHCR and other partners.

Achievements:

SYRIA

 A plan has been developed to share data connectivity with the humanitarian community based in the Four Seasons hotel. This will be shared within the next few days.

JORDAN

- UNHCR has installed a VHF repeater in Zaatari refugee camp which has significantly improved radio coverage.
- The local ETC Working Group meeting took place on 18/08/2013.

LEBANON

• WFP has reached an agreement with the Lebanese government which should

expedite the customs clearance procedure for ETC and ICT equipment en route to Syria.

IRAQ

- The ETC contingency plan for 2013 has been submitted.
- To date, UNAMI have been leading the ETC in Iraq, however they have now requested that WFP take over this role.

Challenges and Gaps:

SYRIA

- The volatile security situation remains a challenge to deployment in the field.
- Licensing and importation of telecommunications equipment into Damascus remains a challenge.

Planned Activities:

JORDAN

- Radios in the Zaatari refugee camp will be reprogrammed in line with updated frequencies and code plugs.
- There are plans to establish a COMCEN in Al Azraq refugee camp within the next couple of months.

TURKEY

• A COMCEN in Gaziantep will be established in the WFP office. Requests have been submitted to Turkish authorities to approve the premises so the infrastructure can be upgraded to meet security requirements.
