## ETC Situation Report #3

## Reporting period 22/12/13 to 31/12/13

### **Highlights**

- Since the declaration of the humanitarian system-wide emergency in the Central African Republic, the Emergency Telecommunications Cluster (ETC) has gearing up its capacity with the deployment of additional staff and equipment.
- ETC and UNDSS are working together to improve and extend radio communications systems in Bangui.

### **Cluster Responsibilities**

• WFP is leading the ETC is CAR. The ETC is responsible for providing emergency telecommunications support to humanitarian organizations on the ground.

#### Achievements

- In addition to the ETC Coordinator and the Information Management Officer, the FITTEST ICT Technician is now arrived in Bangui.
- 6 Tons of ETC equipment was received on 27/12/2013 and delivered on 28/12/2013. The inventory of all items was completed.
- ETC and UNDSS met on 25/12/2013 to discuss ways of improving the security communications systems in Bangui and recruiting additional radio operators for the radio rooms in the field.

#### **Challenges and Gaps**

- 1 Tons of ETC equipment is still due to arrive, however due to the closure of the Bangui airport on 31/12/2013, no arrival date is yet confirmed.
- The C-MOSS requirements state that COMCENs need to be 24/7 operational in all common operational areas. However besides Bangui, requirements are not met due to lack of radio operators and the current security situation.
- The ETC is only 35% funded which is only enough for deployment to four locations.

#### **Planned Activities**

- ETC will request additional funding to CERF as planned to support the CAR Humanitarian 100-day plan.
- ETC and UNDSS will look at starting process of recruitment of additional radio operators with UNDP to ensure full 24/7 operational COMCENs in all common operational areas in the field.
- ETC is working on strengthening and extending the radio communications network in Bangui and deploying a dedicated channel for the NGOs operating in Bangui.
- The ETC plans to support the establishment of common ICT services in seven field locations and the capital as follow:
  - Deployment of fully operational COMCENs and data connectivity in Bambari, Kaga Bandoro and Bossangoa as part of phase 1.
  - Deployment of fully operational COMCENs and data connectivity in Zemio, Ndele, Paoua, and Bouar as part of phase 2.
  - Enhance security telecommunications in Bangui.
