NGO Engagement Strategy Process

- **Genesis:** Collaborative effort by TSF, WVI, NetHope, WFP and Global ETC Support Cell
- **Objective:** Strengthen partnership between ETC and NGOs – to enable more effective humanitarian work
- **Status:** “Listening mode” – hearing the voice of NGO community (survey, interviews)

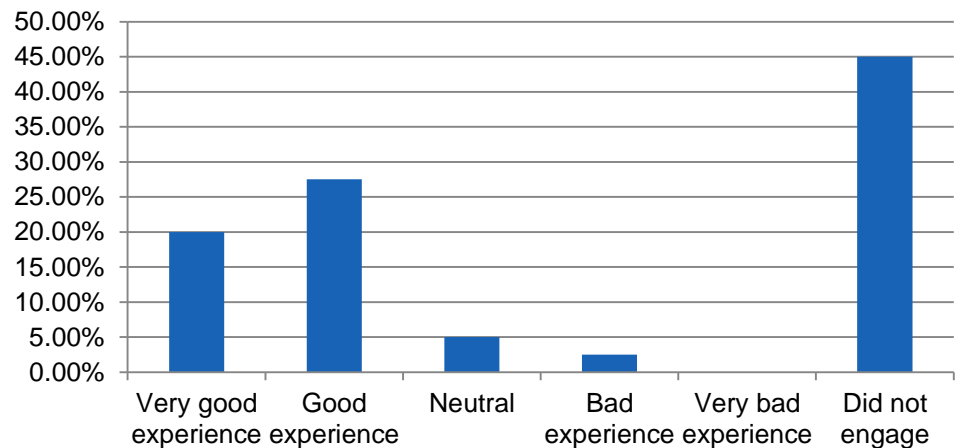

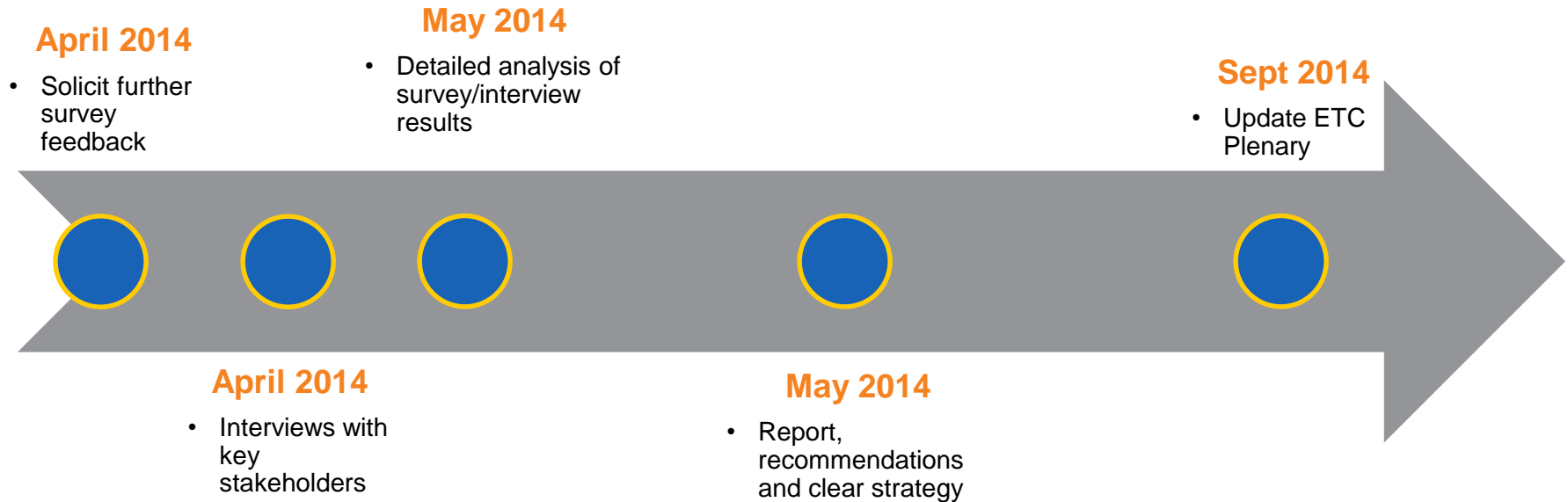
Survey Preliminary Highlights

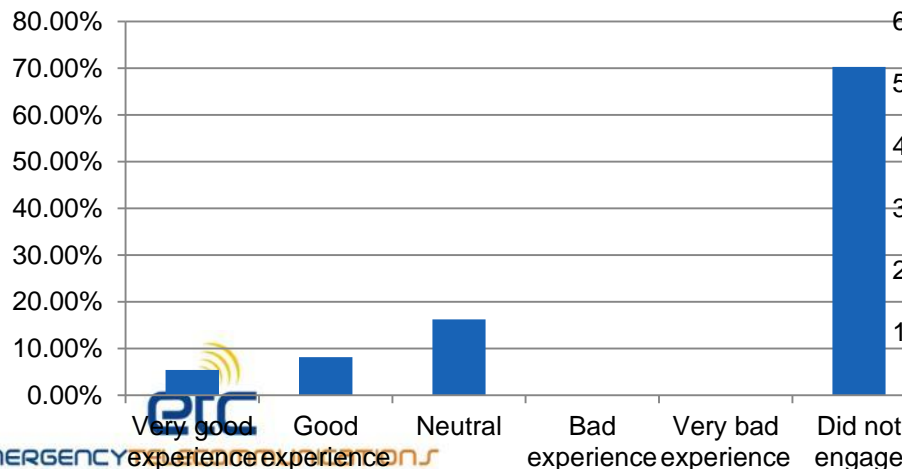

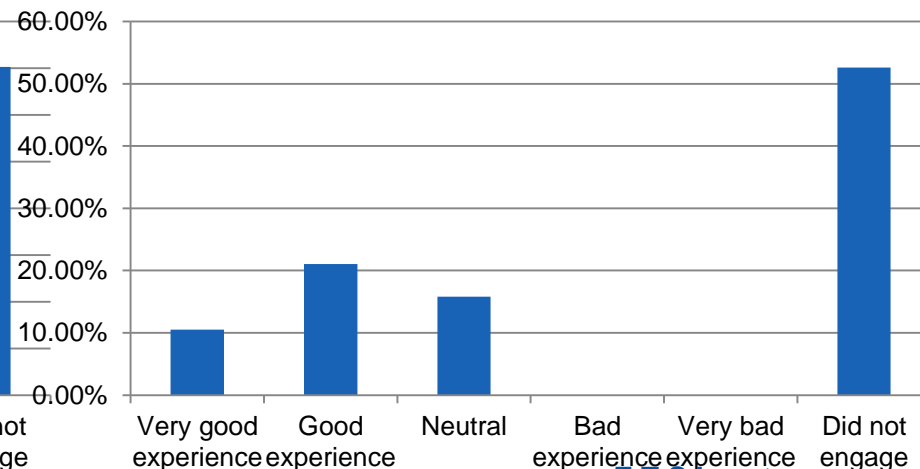

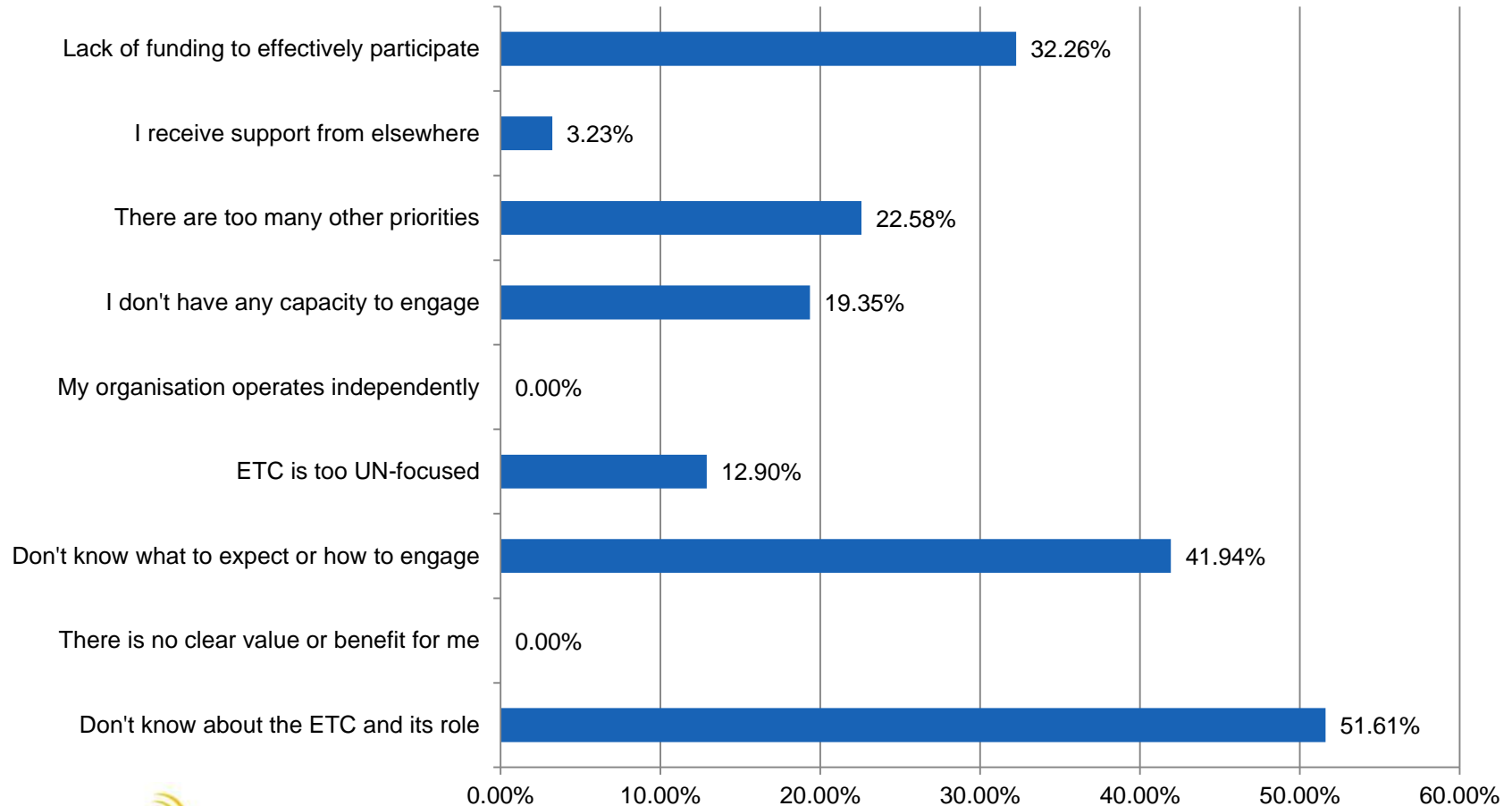
