COUNTRY EMERGENCY REVIEW

MALI / C.A.R.

The 4 key highlights / issues prioritized are:

1. Redundancy of ETC solutions
2. Manage the expectations: bandwidth / services catalogue
3. Improve exit strategy / long term funding
4. Capacity building of local ICT Working Groups before the emergency
5. Customs issues – positive (ETC role) - still need improvement

Syria / Libya

The 4 key highlights / issues prioritized are:

1. Licensing and importation of equipment – together or separate?
2. Continuity of ETC Coordinator role / Building local capacity where possible
3. Definition of services, roles and responsibilities between UNHCR and ETC
4. Sharing information between partners and organizations – knowing what services are being provided by who and where

Philippines

The 4 key highlights / issues prioritized are:

1. Information sharing in the field
2. Local level preparedness (sustainability)
3. Continuity in leadership – rosters
4. Bring your own device and challenges of customer support

South Sudan

The 4 key highlights / issues prioritized are:

1. Customs Strategy required
2. Improve ETC Response Planning – inclusion of partners and priorities on ETC staff and services to be deployed (Coordination)
3. Lack of Staff skills locally
4. Mitigation of security constraints

REPORTING AND WAY FORWARD

Top 3 - 5 solutions per issues

1. Leadership continuity / local capacity building / sustainability / interoperability:
 - Exit strategy from beginning
 - Hand-over during rotation
 - Identify and train local capacity when available
2. Customs and licensing strategy:
 - Establish MoU Partnerships beyond
 - Establish data base of country level frequencies
3. Sharing of Information
 - Joint communications teams
 - Manage expectation of service delivery in emergencies
4. Security:
 - Cloud / data
 - Radio deployment of equipment
 - Redundancy on ETC solution / connectivity



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
