

Central African Republic ETC Situation Report #8 Reporting period 17/02/14 to 31/03/14

Highlights

- A COMCEN has been installed in the UNICEF compound in Bossangoa, improving coordination and the safety and security of humanitarian workers operating there.
- A mission was deployed to Bouar on 25/03/14 to upgrade a COMCEN.

Cluster Responsibilities

• WFP is leading the ETC in CAR. The ETC is responsible for providing emergency telecommunications support to humanitarian organizations on the ground.

Achievements

- Ekue Ayih, Senior FITTEST Specialist, has replaced Ivan Thomas as ETC Coordinator.
- A COMCEN has been installed in the UNICEF compound in Bossangoa, improving coordination and the safety and security of humanitarian workers operating there.
- Equipment has been prepositioned in Paoua and Bouar in preparation for deployment.
- A mission was deployed to Bouar on 25/03/14 to upgrade a COMCEN.
- An agreement with Orange, a mobile service provider operating in the country, has been reached in which the ETC will be granted use of a tower in Kaga-Bandoro for a discounted rate.
- Two additional staff members joined the operation from DRC on 24/03/14.
- The ETC team continues supporting radio programming for humanitarian organizations operating in Bangui. To date the ETC has programmed radios for 10 humanitarian organisations.

Challenges and Gaps

• The volatile security situation prevents deployment to certain locations.

• The funding situation remains critical, however around US\$300,000 is expected within the coming days. Additional funding is required to maintain operations at their current level.

Planned Activities

- Deployment to Bouar is planned before the end of the month, security permitting.
- Deployments to Kaga-Bandoro, Paoua, Bambari, N'Délé and Zemio are planned for April.
- Recruitment of additional radio operators to ensure radio rooms in operational areas are active 24/7.
