ETC Situation Report #43

Highlights

- On 16/04/2014, the ETC completed a four-day mission to Malakal during which all necessary equipment for the establishment of a radio room was installed, radio maintenance for humanitarian vehicles was carried out and training was provided to humanitarian staff to improve security in the field.

Cluster Responsibilities

- WFP is leading ETC activities in RoSS with responsibility for coordination, implementation and overall operational support for common ICT services.

Achievements

- Between 12-16/04/2014, the ETC installed all necessary equipment for the establishment of a radio room in Malakal. Furthermore, the ETC performed radio maintenance of several vehicles and provided training to humanitarian staff to improve security and coordination capability of the humanitarian community.
- A solar kit was installed inside the humanitarian hub in Mingkaman on 15/04/2014 to provide uninterrupted power and internet connectivity for humanitarian organizations working there.
- The ETC continues to programme radios and allocate call signs to all NGOs and UN Agencies in South Sudan. This week, the ETC programmed 26 radios for NGOs and UN Agencies. This makes it easier for humanitarian workers to communicate and improves security in the field.
- Currently, there are eight sites in South Sudan being provided with ETC internet connectivity.

Challenges and Gaps

- Procurement of IT and communication equipment continues to be challenging in light of the volatile security situation, leading to substantial delays. At the same time, the availability of suitable supplies, such as internet connectivity kits and solar panels, continues to be very limited in-country.



Planned Activities

- ICT equipment is set to be transported to Nassir on 23/04/2014. The ETC will dispatch a team to establish internet connectivity for humanitarian organizations operating in Nassir.
- A mission to Maban is planned for the week of 21/04/2014 to carry out maintenance of telecommunications equipment and assess the needs of humanitarian partners.
- The ETC plans to increase bandwidth in Bentiu to provide faster internet to humanitarian partners.

- The next Global ETC teleconference will be held on 28/04/14.
