

Republic of South Sudan (RoSS) ETC Situation Report #44 Reporting period 21/04/14 to 27/04/14

Highlights

 The ETC currently has teams in Maban, Bentiu, Malakal and Bor, carrying out maintenance of security telecommunications equipment and expansion of internet connectivity for humanitarian partners. All missions will be concluded by 02/05/2014 and are expected to increase the coordination capacity of humanitarian organizations and security in the field.

Cluster Responsibilities

 WFP is leading ETC activities in RoSS with responsibility for coordination, implementation and overall operational support for common ICT services.

Achievements

- A maintenance mission requested by UN agencies commenced on 23/04/2014 in Maban. Activities
 performed by the ETC include the programming of radios, maintenance and repair of telecommunications
 equipment in humanitarian vehicles and ICT support for humanitarian partners. The assistance provided
 by the ETC is expected to increase the coordination capacity of humanitarian organizations based in
 Maban and to improve security communications in the field.
- Between 25-27/04/2014 the ETC performed internet connectivity maintenance at the Save the Children compound in Mingkaman and carried out needs assessments at both sites serviced by the ETC. Feedback from UN Agencies and NGOs indicated that internet connectivity has been working well inside the humanitarian hub and played an essential role in coordinating the crisis response in a timely manner. The installation of additional solar panels in the week of 15/04/2014 further decreased power outages.
- On 25/04/2014, the ETC dispatched a team to Bentiu to upgrade bandwidth and implement a user administration system, allowing humanitarians to benefit from faster internet access. Furthermore, an assessment will be carried out to determine the needs of humanitarian partners on the ground.
- Currently, there are eight sites in South Sudan being provided with ETC internet connectivity.



Challenges and Gaps

 Procurement of IT and communication equipment continues to be challenging in light of the volatile security situation, leading to substantial delays. At the same time, the availability of suitable supplies, such as internet connectivity kits and solar kits, continues to be very limited in-country.

Planned Activities

- In the week of 28/04/2014, an ETC team will meet with humanitarian partners in Malakal to discuss needs
 and requirements going forward. Moreover, a user administration system will be put in place for the
 internet connection provided by the ETC to balance available bandwidth more efficiently and allow all
 humanitarians to enjoy sufficiently fast internet.
- The ETC sent a team to Bor on 28/04/2014. VHF connectivity is scheduled to be reestablished for UN agencies to increase security and coordination capacity in the field.

- The next Global ETC teleconference will be held on 05/05/14.
