

Republic of South Sudan (RoSS) ETC Situation Report #48 Reporting period 19/05/14 to 25/05/14

Highlights

• Last week, the ETC completed a mission to Mingkaman during which maintenance of security telecommunications equipment was carried out. Furthermore, the ETC provided ICT support to humanitarians based at the humanitarian hub in Mingkaman, programmed radios for NGOs and increased the range of wireless internet coverage.

Cluster Responsibilities

• WFP is leading ETC activities in RoSS with responsibility for coordination, implementation and overall operational support for common ICT services.

Achievements

- On 22-23/05/14, the ETC carried out an assessment mission in Ganyiel, Unity State, to determine ICT needs on the ground. The mission confirmed the presence of IRC, German Agro Action, Medair, Mercycorps, Ecom, Winrock International, RRC as well as WFP airdrop teams, amounting to a total of 84 humanitarians. As internet connectivity provided by IRC is very limited and insufficient for the amount of users present, the ETC has started preparations to deploy an internet connectivity kit for humanitarians based in Ganyiel.
- An ETC mission took place in Mingkaman, Lakes State, between 21-23/05/14. Apart from necessary
 maintenance works due to heavy rainfall, ICT support was provided to humanitarians based in
 Mingkaman and radios were programmed for NGOs. Furthermore, VHF network equipment was replaced
 to ensure uninterrupted functionality of security telecommunications equipment and to increase security in
 the field.
- A Local ETC Working Group meeting was held in Juba on 22/05/14. Participants from seven different humanitarian organisations attended this meeting to share updates and information about the ETC response to this emergency.
- Currently, there are eight sites in South Sudan being provided with ETC internet connectivity: Juba-3, Juba Tomping, Mingkaman Humanitarian Hub, Mingkaman Save the Children Compound, Nimule, Bentiu, Bor and Malakal.

The ETC provides timely, predictable and effective Information Communications Technology services to support the humanitarian community in carrying-out their work efficiently, effectively and safely.



Challenges and Gaps

- Despite the ceasefire agreement signed between government and opposition leaders on 09/05/14, clashes and high-levels of insecurity continue to be reported in Upper Nile State, causing further delays of the planned shipment of a new internet connectivity kit to Nassir.
- Procurement of telecommunications equipment continues to be challenging as lengthy import procedures and the volatile security situation frequently cause significant delays.

Planned Activities

• An assessment mission to Melut, Upper Nile State, is scheduled to take place in the week of 26/05/14 to assess needs on the ground and determine whether an ETC intervention is needed.

Meetings

- The next Local ETC meeting will be held on 05/06/14.
- The next Global ETC teleconference will be held on 02/06/14.
