

Central African Republic ETC Situation Report #10 Reporting period 12/05/14 to 23/06/14

Highlights

- In Bangui, the radio room was upgraded and VHF handsets were deployed. This has stabilised radio coverage in the Capital.
- Radio frequencies have been compiled in preparation for the planned expansion of radio coverage in the border regions of C.A.R. and Cameroon. This will improve the coordination and security of humanitarian staff working on cross-border operations such as the refugee crisis.

Cluster Responsibilities

• WFP is leading the ETC in C.A.R.. The ETC is responsible for providing emergency telecommunications support to humanitarian organizations on the ground.

Achievements

- Nyanaprakash Muniandy, Senior FITTEST Specialist, has been deployed as the ETC Coordinator.
- The security situation has improved slightly which has allowed the resumption of certain ETC activities in the field.
- In Bangui, the radio room was upgraded and VHF handsets were deployed. This has stabilised radio coverage in the Capital.
- Repeater sites in Bangui have also been upgraded. Solar panels have been installed to ensure continuous operation.
- Radio frequencies have been compiled in preparation for the planned expansion of radio coverage in the border regions of C.A.R. and Cameroon. This will improve the coordination and security of humanitarian staff working on cross-border operations such as the refugee crisis.
- Discussions are being held with the mobile operator Orange regarding the use of their tower in Kaga-Bandoro. It is possible they will allow the ETC use of this tower once staff are deployed to the town.
- A budget revision is ongoing.

Challenges and Gaps

- Additional staff are urgently required, particularly with telecommunications expertise and VSAT certification.
- The volatile security situation prevents deployment to certain locations.
- The funding situation remains critical, and is preventing the deployment of additional staff.
- Flights within the country are severely restricted due to a lack of fuel. This makes it hard to deploy and preposition equipment.
- Limited office space remains a challenge. Discussions are ongoing about how the ETC can best provide services in locations in which there is no permanent office.

Planned Activities

• Deployment is planned in a number of locations including Kaga-Bandoro, Bossangoa, N'Délé and Bouar.
