Highlights

- ETC internet connectivity is now available for all humanitarian organizations at both Domiz and Arbat camps.
- Internet connectivity has been extended to a transit camp 7 kms away from Arbat camp via microwave link.

Cluster Responsibilities

• WFP is leading ETC activities in Iraq. The ETC is responsible for providing emergency telecommunications support to humanitarian organizations on the ground.

Achievements

- ETC wireless internet connectivity is now available in a number of locations in Arbat camp outside Sulaymaniyah, and is available to all humanitarian organizations operating there. This will improve communication and coordination of relief operations there. Locations include:
 - The UN compound.
 - The International Rescue Committee and UNHCR offices.
 - The offices of NGO emergency.it.
 - Save the Children office.
 - The admin building.
- ETC wireless connectivity is also being provided at four locations in Domiz camp outside of Dohuk city, and is available to all organizations operating there. Locations are:

- The UN compound
- The Norwegian Refugee Council offices
- Two government Development and Modification Centres (DMC).
- Internet connectivity has also been extended to a transit camp 7 kms away from Arbat camp via microwave link.
- A Radio Trainer has been deployed and radio training is now being provided to humanitarian staff in Erbil. This will improve staff safety and security.
- Radio programming for UN agencies on behalf of UNAMI is ongoing.
- Radio rooms are operational in Dohuk and Sulaymaniyah.
 - Radio services are currently being provided by UNAMI and only available to UN staff. However the ETC will establish inter-agency radio services in the coming weeks.
- The ETC and UNAMI continue to work together to enhance digital radio services being provided to UN agencies.

Challenges and Gaps

- Flight options for the importation of equipment remain limited. This can delay the deployment of humanitarian ICT services.
- Any staff deployed to Iraq who wish to travel outside Erbil must attend SAIT training, which takes four days, and apply for a residency which can also take a few days. This can delay deployment.
- The ETC currently only has four pairs of frequencies which limits the deployment of radio services.

Planned Activities

- Two FITTEST telecommunications specialists will be deployed to Sulaymaniyah and Dohuk on 15/10/14 to establish inter-agency radio services at IDP/refugee camps outside the cities, with assistance from UNAMI.
 - They will also provide radio training and programming services to staff in both cities.
- Establishment of inter-agency radio services in Erbil is planned for next week after UNAMI approved the installation of a repeater on the roof of the Erbil International Hotel.
 - Radio operators will be recruited for the radio room in Erbil to enhance staff and vehicle tracking capacity.
- An additional shipment of ICT equipment is expected to be received on 15/10/14.
