ETC is operational in Baghdad, Basrah, Erbil, Dahuk, Sulaymaniya, Domiz and Arbat camps.

1. <u>UPDATES</u>

BAGHDAD

 A new security simplex RX only Announcement channel has been established and has been added to the Humanitarian agency codeplug. Reprogramming and configuring radios is ongoing together with UNAMI CITS. All agency staff on mission to Baghdad must have this channel configured and can request ETC support for reconfiguring as required.

ERBIL

Nothing significant to report.

SULAYMANIYA

• An additional radio operator is still required.



COMCEN is still operating 24/7.

DAHUK

- An additional two radio operators are required.
- A mission to Dahuk has moved the COMCEN from the UNHCR office and reinstalled all equipment in the WFP office in the Jihan Hotel, the COMCEN is operational again.
- COMCEN is operating 12/7.

DOMIZ CAMP

• ETC distributes 2 Mbps bandwidth via multiple access points in the camp.

ARBAT CAMP

- ETC distributes 2 Mbps bandwidth via an Ericsson WIDER system and multiple access points in the camp.
- 77 confirmed and 111 accumulated users are registered on the WIDER network.

STAFF

• A FITTEST Engineer has departed for Emergency IT Management training in Pisa.

TRAINING

- The ETC continues to configure radios for UN agencies and NGOs with a standard CP compatible with both digital (IP Connect/Linked Capacity +) and analogue radio networks.
 To date, over 412 individual radios have been processed.
- Radio training is being delivered by the ETC and UNAMI to UN and NGO staff on an
 ongoing basis. This is to ensure correct radio protocol is consistently followed by all to
 facilitate the safety of staff. To date, the ETC has trained approximately 136 staff from
 various humanitarian organisations.

FINANCIALS

- Funding shortfall from the original operational plan: \$601,561
- A budget revision as a part of the HRP for \$501K to cover the remainder of 2015 ETC operations has recently been fully funded.

AOB

- A local contractor will commence installation of a 30ft guyed tower on the Sulaymaniya COMCEN to provide better local area repeater coverage and antenna separation.
- A reminder, the country-wide CP's have been finalised thanks to support from UNAMI, contact ETC for support in reprogramming.
- Additional reminder, every Monday 1000hrs, a radio-training is conducted by UNAMI, open to all agencies, book in advance through CITS or ETC. A reminder will be posted on the ETC emergency website.
