1.	<p><u>ETC Update</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ETC services in Wau will remain up to the end of December 2016 due to demands. Leer and Koch response will be carried out by 2017. Issues on communications equipment licensing remain a challenge as the government have no clear policies yet on what will be the official procedures in registering the equipment. Issues with government being able to access to WFP radio channels and claiming it is their channel is a concern in Wau. ETC is trying to get hold with the concern authority to discuss matters relating to the issue on licensing and frequency interference. 	Richard Egwangu (WFP)	
2	<p><u>Digital Mobile Radio</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Technical staff from the global service provider have received their clearance to enter the country from the Foreign Ministry and expected to arrive on third week of November. The mission will install the digital repeaters in identified sites in Juba. The equipment will eliminate the frequency interference during radio transmission in the radio coverage area and provide full digital functionalities. <p><u>Roundtable Discussion</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Government representative had asked some organizations in some states to register their VSAT equipment, otherwise, will be confiscated. LTA should also be pursued with MTN, ZAIN and VIVACELL (local service providers for GSM and internet) OCHA requesting hands-on training of staff on installing VHF radio in vehicles. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Target training date for VHF installation in vehicles will be on second week of November for 30 participants. <p>Action Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ETC to escalate the issue on registration to the Operations Management Team (OMT), Office of Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA). ETC partners should forward the latest list of their staff radios from their agencies with serial numbers to be inputted in the digital system. ETC to pursue getting Long-Term Agreements (LTAs) through the OMT with various IT equipment suppliers to facilitate the procurement process.
