Minutes

1. ETC Update - Mozambique

- No security issues to report.
- In Beira, ETC Working Group meetings are held weekly and inter-cluster coordination meetings three times a week.
- Currently, there are 1,450 users registered to access ETC Internet connectivity in Beira and Buzi (where WIDER kits are deployed). In addition, the ETC is providing connectivity at 16x sites in Beira. Outside Beira, the ETC has deployed satellite kits to provide connectivity in Buzi, Grudja and Nhamatanda.
 - A team is in Buzi today to replace the rapid deploy satellite terminal with a fixed base satellite terminal which is a longer-term solution.
 - The team will also conduct an assessment of Guara Guara which may become a returnees' camp in which case UN and NGO hubs will be established.
 - Eutelsat satellite terminals were installed in Grudja and Nhamatanda.
- The ETC security telecommunications specialist is building a Communications Centre (COMCEN) in Beira. The repeaters are already active with a UN channel and an NGO channel; coverage reaches as far as Buzi. The recruitment of three radio operators is planned.
- There are still some issues with electricity in Beira. The electricity company is focusing on repairing hospitals, clinics, schools, government buildings and water treatment plants first.
- Mobile Network Operators (MNOs) and Internet Service Providers (ISPs) are still having issues. ISPs have brought all staff to Beira to complete repairs of the network. Yesterday, there were numerous issues with mobile networks and issues with ISPs last week as road repair crews cut through the cable.
- Tomorrow, a specialized satellite terminal (O3B) provided by the Government of Luxembourg is due to arrive in Beira to improve connectivity.
- Two Ericsson Response staff will leave this week and their replacements are already on the ground. The ETC IMO will leave this week but will continue to support from Dubai. The NetHope team member who is NGO Coordinator for the ETC will leave at the end of the week.
- Regarding Services for Communities (S4C) activities, technical assessments of six community radio stations in Sofala province are complete together with the National Forum of Community Radios in Mozambique (FORCOM). The S4C advisor is planning the procurement in order to support the rehabilitation of these community radios.
