1. Brief update on the latest ETS activities in NE Nigeria

- The ETS continues to provide security telecommunications, data connectivity, voice, Information Management and coordination services to humanitarian responders.
- The ETS provides a blend of services in 10 common operational areas in the North East region.
- So far this year, the ETS has provided internet services in eight common operational areas to approximately 4,356 users from 114 organizations (15 UN agencies and 99 NGOs).
- This year, ETS has trained 165 humanitarians on security communications standard procedures, building their capacity in communicating effectively.
- The COVID-19 imposed travel restrictions have affected some ETS activities, thereby impacting our annual KPIs.
- There is also a funding shortfall and, the Country Office management team is working on securing more funds for the operation.
- The installation of the hybrid solar power solution at the humanitarian hubs will commence soonto provide backup connectivity for ETS equipment. The ETS team is working to ensure staff and technicians are deployed to the field in the coming weeks.
- ETS also plans to upgrade the Damaturu Security Operations Centre (SOC) to include vehicle and personnel tracking services.
- There were enquiries about the deployment of ETS services in Rann. The ETS put the Rann deployment on hold as there is no security clearance from UNDSS and no humanitarian hub in that location.
- The ETS IT associate shared his experience in the field locations and requested the members of
 the local working group to encourage their team members to comply with the ETS IT user policies
 as these are put in place to optimize the bandwidth available for humanitarians in the field.
