### Action Items/ Decisions

UN ICT Ref group

The ICT Ref Group provides guidance on the **coordination of country-level ICT activities of UN agencies** where a harmonized approach can provide results:

- Provide guidance on ICT investment, including cost-benefit analysis,
- Provide guidance on mechanisms to address country-level common ICT service needs
- identify opportunities for synergies, harmonization and consolidation
- -> toward harmonizing ICT activities in country offices,
- -> ensures these activities align with common ICT strategic goals for participating organizations





### Action Items/ Decisions

#### Operational recommendations to take forward.

- 1. Leadership continuity, local capacity building and sustainability:
- a) Ensure to include exit strategy from the beginning of projects.
- b) Ensure proper hand-over during rotation.
- c) Identify and train local capacity when available.
- 2. Customs and licensing strategy:
- a) Establish MoU / partnerships.
- b) Establish data base of country level frequencies.
- 3. Sharing of Information
- a) Establish joint communications teams in field operations.
- b) Manage expectation of service delivery in emergencies.
- 4. Security:
- a) Utilize Cloud / data to ensure data is not exposed on site.
- b) Ensure to deploy the security communications services in common operational areas.
- c) Ensure redundancy on ETC solution / connectivity.
