IN DECEMBER 2013

In the Central African Republic, the ETC supports the provision of common ICT services in 13 common operational areas, namely: Alindao, Bambari, Bangassou, Bangui, Birao, Batangafo, Bossangoa, Bouar, Bria, Kaga-Bandoro, N'Délé, Paoua and Zemio. The ETC is focusing on enhancing security telecommunications infrastructure throughout the country in collaboration with other agencies and the Telecommunications Security Standards (TESS) project. The ETC is providing services for communities in Bangui and Bria.

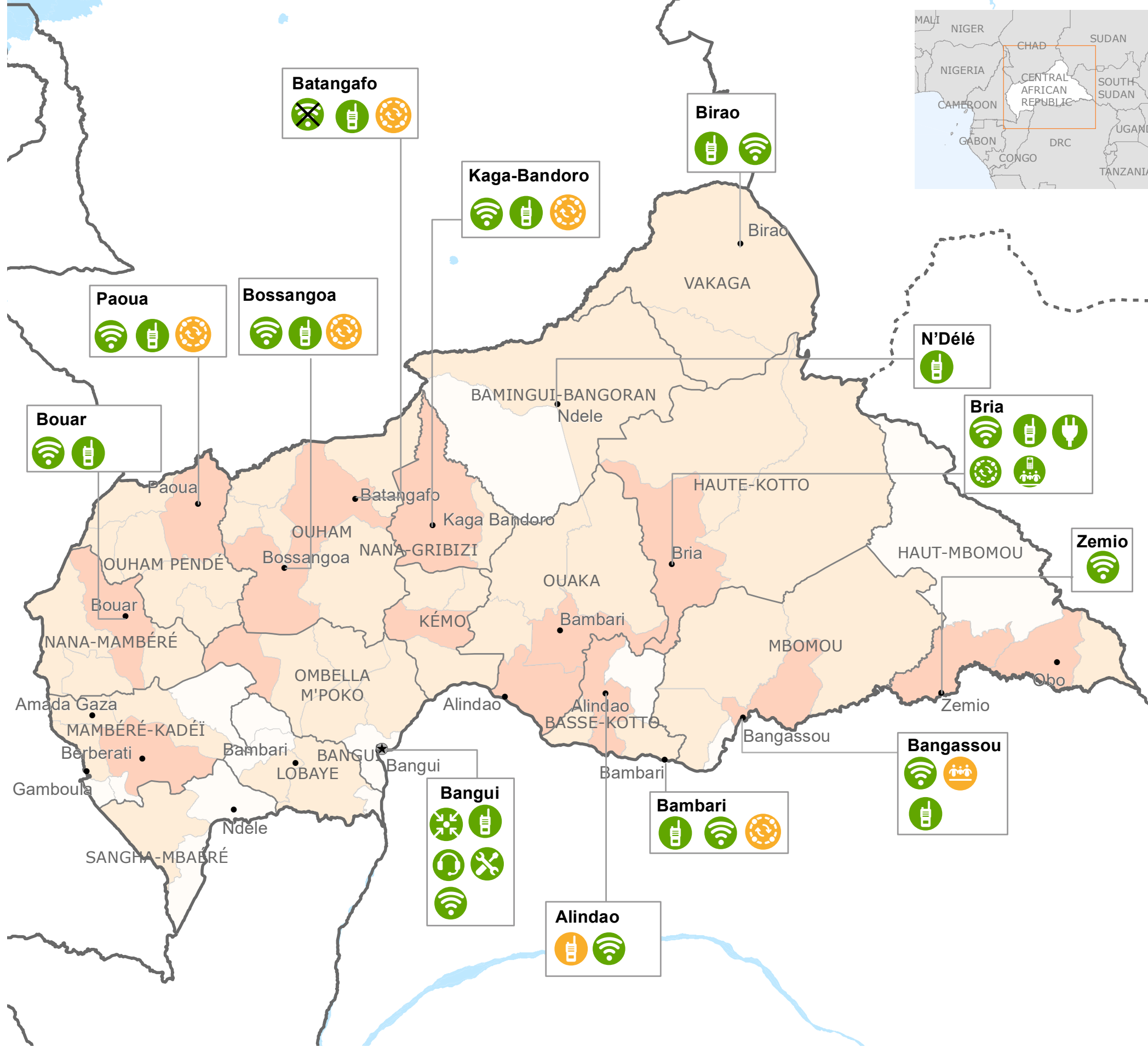
