on 25 May 2023

Since the outbreak of conflict across Sudan on 15 April 2023, the Emergency Telecommunications Cluster (ETC) has been closely monitoring the impacts to telecommunications infrastructure. An ETC Coordinator is on the ground in Port Sudan and the cluster is mobilising further resources to meet the needs for common ICT services as organisations scale up their operations within the country.

The ETC is planning to provide

- Internet connectivity
- Security communications services
- ICT Helpdesk

in 10 Common Operational Areas

- And will establish platforms for communication between humanitarians and the affected population
