As part of the Emergency Telecommunications Cluster (ETC) capacity building program, we are glad to announce that we will be hosting two five-day **Let's Comm Digital training sessions on MotoTRBO Digital VHF radio infrastructure deployment**.

The training will be facilitated by the WFP FITTEST team.

The two sessions will take from **16 to 20 and from 23 to 27 May 2016**. Venue will be in Jebel Lodge, in Jebel Kujur, Juba, South Sudan.

For each session a maximum of 12 participants from UN agencies, NGOs and the Government will be invited. Each participant may attend one five-day training session.

Participants should have a technical background in VHF/UHF radio communications.

All training materials are in English only and, given the technical nature of the content, students must have strong English skills to successfully complete the course.
