IN DECEMBER 2021

Following the Super Typhoon Rai/Odette that made landfall on several central and southern islands of the Philippines on 16 December, the Global Emergency Telecommunications Cluster (ETC) is coordinating with its partners globally and in-country to assess the needs on the ground and preparing to mobilize any support required by the Government of the Philippines.

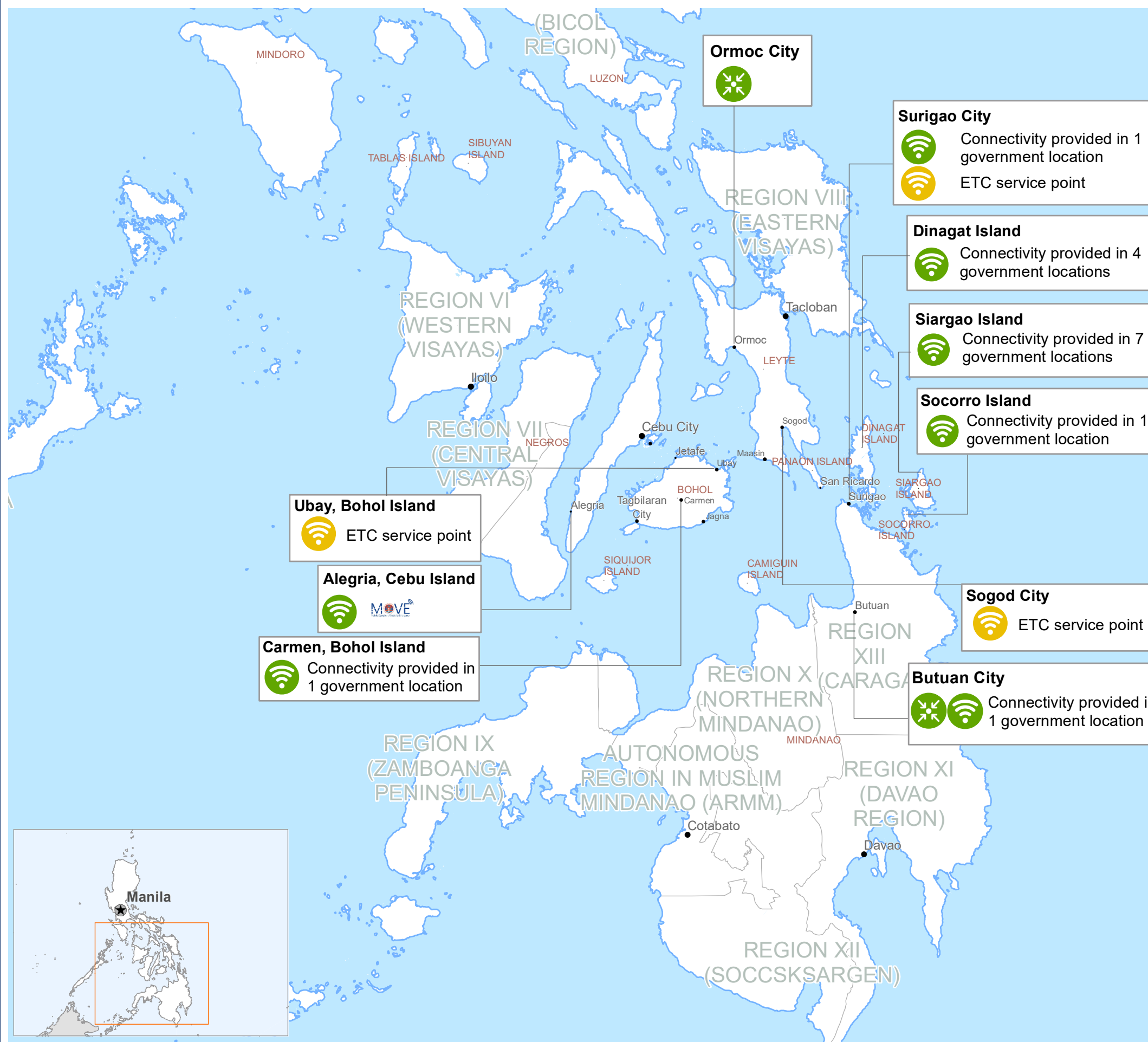
