Following the activation of the ETC in Sudan, the cluster is working to expand common internet services to new sites in Port Sudan and new locations across the country.

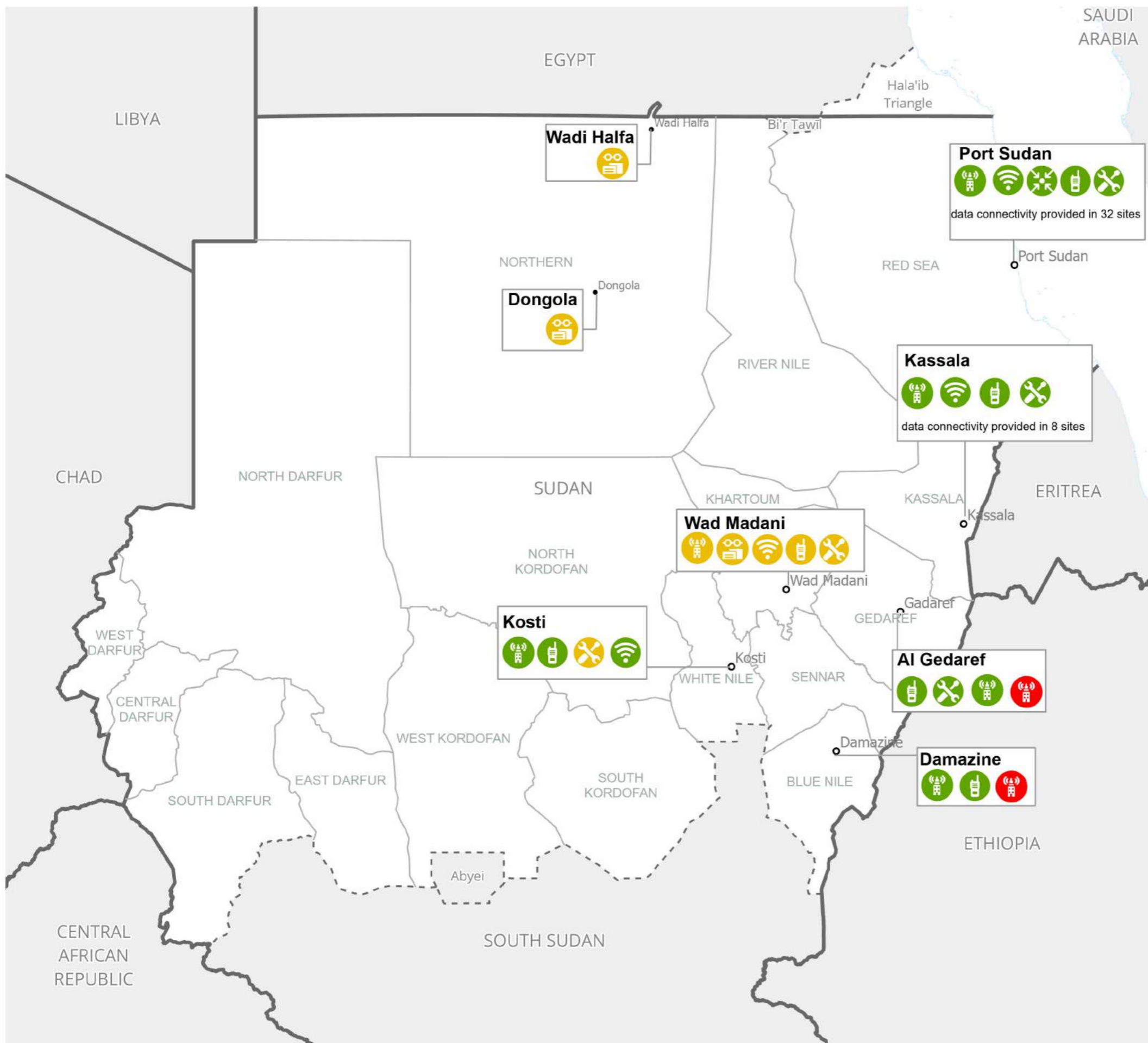
The ETC requires US\$6.3 million in 2024
