



Emergency Telecommunications Cluster (ETC)

The ETC was activated in Syria on 14 January 2013 to provide common telecommunications services to the humanitarian community responding to the crisis both within Syria, and in surrounding countries. Lack of access, escalating insecurity and restrictions on movement complicate these efforts and have at times led to missions being cancelled. However, preparedness plans allow for the immediate expansion of operations once access improves.
