



ETS RESPONSE

16 February to 17 May 2023

The Emergency Telecommunications Sector (ETS) in Türkiye was co-led by WFP and the Government of Türkiye's Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure. The ETS supported the government-led response for three months in the areas impacted by the Kahramanmaraş earthquakes which struck on 06 February 2023. Across eight affected locations, the ETS coordinated the enhancement of data connectivity in common spaces, set up charging stations for communities in temporary settlements, and enhanced or established security communications services.
