- 2** Planned ETC Sites

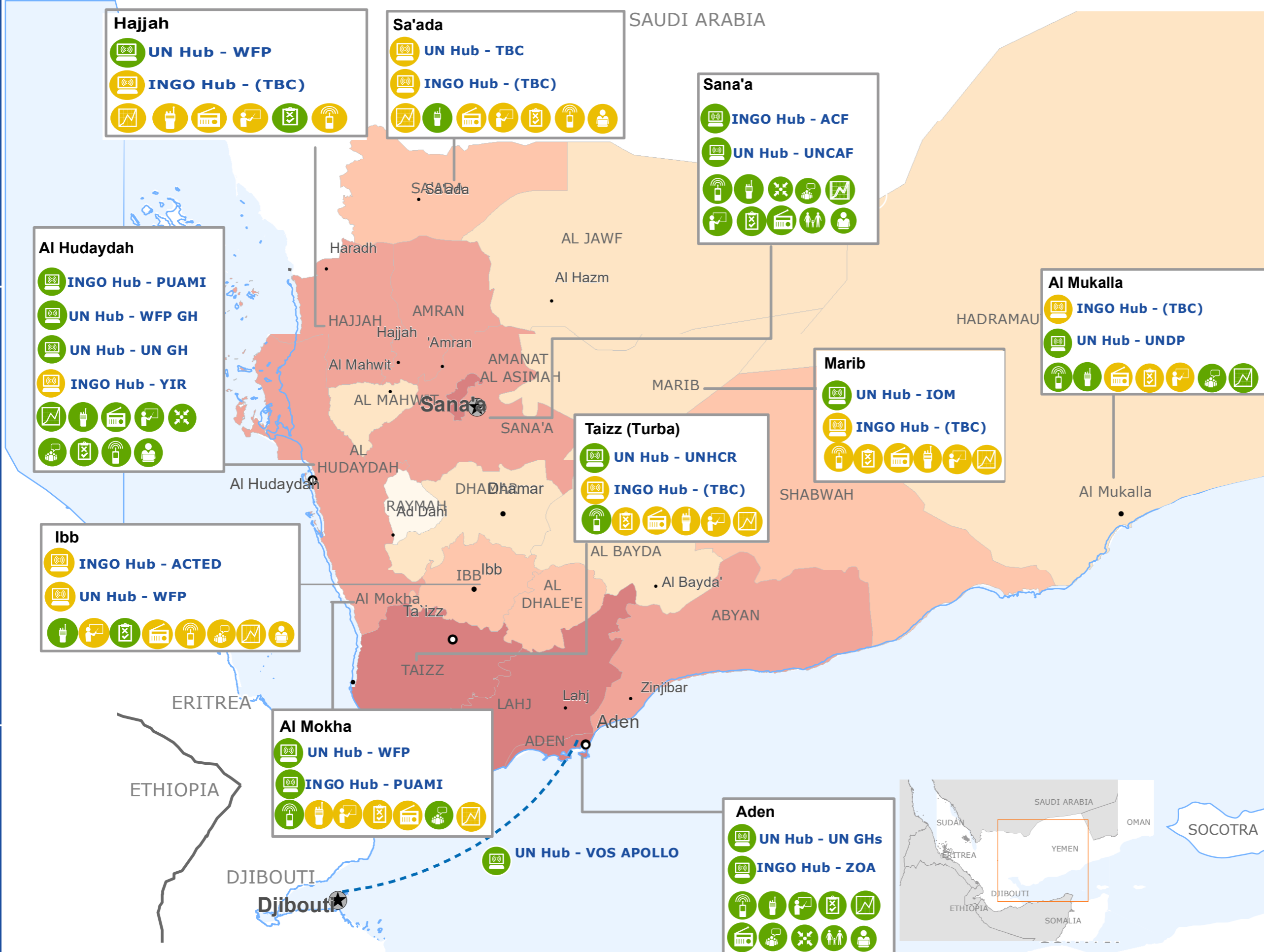
